Footnotes

TWILL DO settled in the rear early, advanced to the front at the 18th fence, drew clear after 19th fence, was challenged by BATTLE OP two fences out, briefly overtaken by that one, and had something left to prevail mid stretch to wire. BATTLE OP jumped well except at 16th where he went to his knees, recovered quickly, closed in on TWILL DO to lead at the final fence, but was outfinished mid stretch. BON CADDO was always never far back, chased late keeping in touch but couldn't reach leaders. PROFESSOR MAXWELL led mid race, was in striking distance late, slipped on the flat in the final bend and lost action. FORT HENRY (IRE) was going well in second on final circuit, stopped to avoid faller at 17th, losing ground and dropping to last position after he got moving again. PROSPECTORS STRIKE had several awkward jumps including 2nd to last, losing ground. AND THE EAGLE FLYS stumbled and recovered at the 16th fence, was in lead when fell at the 17th fence. PRIVATE ATTACK fell at the 13th fence. MORE FASCINATION fell at the 6th fence. WESTERN FLING lost rider at the 2nd fence. VOLLE NOLLE fell at the 5th fence. HADDIX lost rider at the 5th fence.
