Footnotes

PROFESSOR MAXWELL led from the start, jumped fluently throughout, relinquished lead briefly to BATTLE OP at 17th fence, regaining lead when that one lost rider at 19th fence, galloped out unchallenged in the stretch. SAND BOX RULES went unhurried for about 15 fences, moved into contention three fences out, but could not close gap on the winner. GUTS FOR GARTERS (IRE) was never far back, was prominent at fence 17 to 19, then flattened out and kept on same pace to hold third. TWILL DO trailed far back, made a steady moderate advance after fence 19 but had too much to do to be a threat. BON CADDO was never far back, came into contention at then 19th and 20th fence, then weakened. WOODMONT was always outrun, was impeded at 21st fence behind PROSPECTORS STRIKE when that one refused to jump. PROSPECTORS STRIKE was in contention when refused at 21st, veered left and unseated rider. BATTLE OP jumped fluently always tracking leader in second, went to the lead at then 17th fence, got caught in too close at the 19th fence, jumping it awkwardly, stumbling on landing and unseated his rider. BUG EYED WILLY lost his rider jumping the 16th fence. BRANDS HATCH lost his rider at the 14th fence. CATCH THE ECHO lost his rider at the 13th fence. FORT HENRY (IRE) fell at the 6th fence.
