DERWINS PROSPECTOR traveled in close proximity with the other competitors all the way to the twenty-first fence, pushed forward with two fences remaining and took a narrow lead going into the last fence, was headed by DRIFT SOCIETY (IRE) at the last fence, dueled furiously side by side through the stretch, edging forward in the final strides for the victory. DRIFT SOCIETY (IRE) raced in close proximity to other runners throughout, not far back from DERWINS PROSPECTOR after fence twenty-one, ridden vigorously to draw even at the last fence, dueled all out, and fell short in the final strides. OLD TIMER led the group of four runners to fence nineteen, sailed over fence nineteen efficiently to open up a three length lead, was soon joined by the other two runners, put in a choppy half stride at fence twenty-one and unseated the rider. OUR TOWN was in contention till fence ten where he unseated his rider. JOSHUA G. fell at the sixth fence. TERKO SERVICE fell at the sixth fence. GREAT HALO unseated rider at the third fence. SENIOR SENATOR fell at the third fence. SUPER SATURDAY refused and unseated rider at the fourth fence. DE CHERA fell at the third fence
